Academic Calendar

In SWUFE, fall and spring terms last for 19 weeks respectively, including 17 teaching weeks and 2 examination weeks. Summer term lasts for 2 weeks. Every year the school calendar changes according to the different Chinese official holiday arrangement, but usually Fall Term begins in early September to early January, Spring Term from late February to late June and Summer Term is in July.

Admission & Registration

Procedure	Partner University nominates their selected students sending us their names, email address, study duration. To juancheng2016@qq.com or chengjuan@swufe.edu.cn within 20 March for Fall semester and 20 September for Spring Semester.
Application	All nominated students will receive an email with the application instructions and practical information about the exchange program at SWUFE. Students complete their application online. All the required materials need to be uploaded through the online application system, like transcript of records, copy of passport, and others. Acceptance Letter and Study Visa

A valid visa is the only official permit for your legal stay in China. Please monitor your visa status with great attention. To help you successfully apply for your study in China, SWUFE will send an acceptance letter and completed JW202 Form Student Pages to your home university.

The acceptance letter and JW202 form are supposed to be sent to all incoming students from the date below when they are ready.

End of June for Fall semester nominations.

End of December for Spring semester nominations.

Students need to apply for visa X1 or X2 for study in China. Within 48 hours of successful registration, students should register his/her living address at the local police station and complete all other visa-related procedures under the guidance of the RIEM office.



Campus Information

Guanghua Campus	Located at the west 2nd Ring in Qingyang District of Chengdu, standing next to Jinsha Bus Terminal, Guanghua campus is the old campus of SWUFE and currently holds continuing education and language teaching courses.
Liulin Campus	Located in Wenjiang District, Liulin campus is within 20 kilometers' distance from downtown Chengdu and it is now the main campus where all undergraduates, graduates and Phd students study and live. There is a subway line 4 running between Guanghua campus and Liulin Campus every day.

Come to Chengdu

Students are required arrival at Chengdu before class start date. Students need take class in Liulin Campus. Address for Linlin campus in Chinese and English as below:

Students who need airport pick-up service please contact RIEM office at least **ONE WEEK** prior to Airport Pick-up Days and make sure your flight will land at time 8 am to 8 pm. The pick-up service beyond 8 am to 8 pm will not be offered.

There are two airports in Chengdu, namely Chengdu Shuangliu International Airport (CTU) and Chengdu Tianfu International Airport (TFU). The two airports are connected by subway. You can reach the two campuses of SWUFE by subway.

Insurance

It is mandatory for every international student to purchase a Compulsory Insurance designated by us. Upon registration, students are required to pay this insurance fee. Students who fail to pay the insurance fee cannot complete the registration and will be not allowed to extend visa or attend classes. If you already have bought insurance in China (which has to: cover the whole period of your stay in China, have effectiveness no lower than the insurance we designated) and submitted a photocopy of related documents, the Compulsory Insurance will be unnecessary.

Off-Campus Accommodation

SWUFE doesn't provide a student residence for exchange students. However several rental agencies can help students in finding a suitable accommodation. Rent for a two-bedroom apartment with all necessary facilities will be around 1500-2500 CNY/month near Guanghua Campus or 1000-2000 CNY/month near Liulin campus
